

Forms – Fixed Assignee Loss on Claim (HCM-19062)

Resolved an issue where claiming a reopened form could inadvertently clear the Form Assignee, ensuring assignee data remains intact.

Forms – Resolved Multi-User Form Launch Issue (HCM-19188)

Fixed a performance issue that prevented users from starting multi-user forms. This update ensures smoother form initiation and uninterrupted collaboration across teams.

Forms – “More Options” Menu Misalignment Fixed (HCM-19352)
